## Design a Bug Church Competition

To enter this competition, follow the instructions overleaf and draw your design for a “bug church” to be built in our churchyard. Add notes to your design to explain what the different parts are made from and what wildlife you hope each element will attract.

### Prizes

**1<sup>st</sup> Prize** A “bug church” will be built in the churchyard inspired by the winning design. In addition, the winner will receive a smaller bug hotel of their very own, plus a wildlife book. There will also be exciting **Runner Up** prizes.

### Rules

1. The competition is open to all young people in Royston up to and including the age of 11.
2. Entries should be submitted on the entry form (downloadable from our website or available at Royston Parish Church Sunday services) with all information filled in legibly.
3. Entries are to be delivered by post or by hand to The Vicarage, 20 Palace Gardens, Royston SG8 5AD, *or* submitted electronically by scanning the completed entry form and e-mailing it to: [info@roystonparishchurch.uk](mailto:info@roystonparishchurch.uk)
4. All entries to be received by the closing date of 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022. Royston Parish Church is not responsible for late, lost or delayed entries.
5. For practical reasons, the actual bug church that will be constructed may not match the winning design exactly, but elements of the design will be used to inspire the bug church.
6. By entering the competition, participants give their consent to the Eco Church committee using their work in publicity or promotional activities. If an entrant is a winner of the competition, the entrant consents to their name and their winning work being posted on the premises or on the website and social media of Royston Parish Church. The winner (with the permission of the parents/guardians) must agree that they may be asked to be photographed for publicity purposes.
7. The winner of the competition will be decided by a panel of judges.
8. The decision of the judging panel is final and binding on all entrants and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. The competition organisers reserve the right to vary the details of the exact prizes awarded, but any substitutions will be similar and at least the same value.
10. The winners’ names will be announced by 30<sup>th</sup> April on the Royston Parish Church Website.
